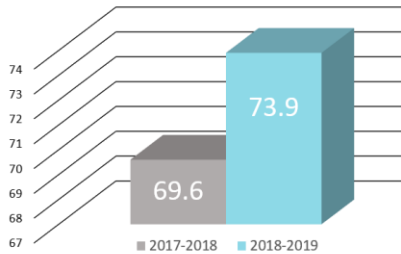
2018-2019 Ohio School Report Card data reveals improvement in Ashtabula Area City Schools.

Measuring student performance on state tests

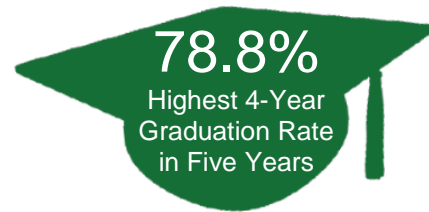

Indicating percentage of students who are successfully finishing high school with a diploma in four years

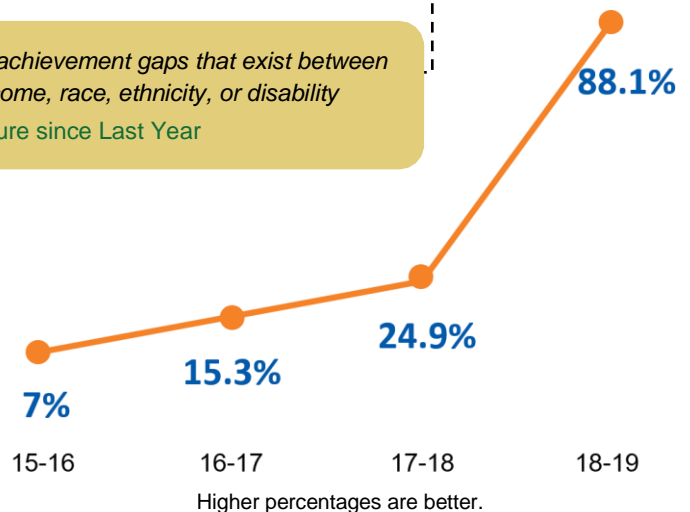
